

DESIGNATION OF VOTING MEMBER

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

Where there is one individual's name on a contract, that person is deemed to be the voting member. *The Act does not allow for proxy votes.* Only a member can vote in person. The name appearing on your bill is the contract holder's name and as such will be deemed to be the voting member. (Contract holders who are directing their bills elsewhere will have their notices sent to that same address)

JOINT MEMBERSHIP

In regard to joint membership (husband, wife or other two or more people) only one of the joint members can receive notice of the meetings, attend the meetings and vote at the meetings. They must designate to the Co-op who that person will be.

MULTIPLE CONTRACT HOLDERS

Multiple contract holders only have one vote regardless of the number of contracts held.

CORPORATIONS

Corporations must designate to the Co-op who its voting representatives will be. That person is not the member but has the right to represent the member's corporation.
